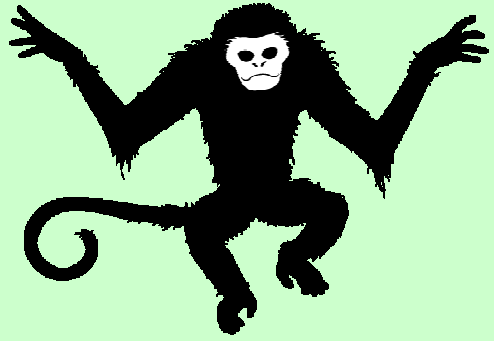

**Guerrilla Productions Director awarded
"Auteur of the Year" by
Blue November Film Festival**



Portland's Guerrilla Productions announces that Director Edward Martin III was awarded *Auteur of the Year* by the Blue November Micro Film Festival.

According to Festival Director Bret Mix: "...the 'Auteur of the Year' award is a special prize given to one filmmaker who typifies the best of the "do-it-yourself" film ethic. In keeping with tradition, this is a non-jury prize and is hand-selected by the festival director to honor multiple achievements of an individual rather than a single work."

"This is just really, really cool," said Martin. "I like to think that people will like *this* movie or *that* movie, but the idea that someone would like the body of work enough to offer me this award, well it just blows me away."

Edward, through Guerrilla Productions and workshops, has been making movies since 2001, starting with the award-winning short "The Testament of Tom Jacoby."
